# Privacy Policy

TRD Network

This Policy explains what personal data TRD Network collects, how it is used and protected, and the rights you have over it. TRD Storage is sovereign by default — you hold your keys.

## 1. Scope

This Privacy Policy applies to personal data processed by TRD Network in connection with TRD Network — the website, dashboard, APIs and products. It does not govern the content you store or process using the Service, which you control.

## 2. Data we collect

- Account data: name, email, organization, and authentication identifiers.
- Usage & billing data: sessions, metered usage, credits, and transaction records.
- Technical data: IP address, device/browser metadata, and security logs.
- Support data: messages and information you provide to support.
- Provider data (Rent & Earn): hardware benchmarks, availability, and payout details.

## 3. How we use data

- To provide, operate, secure and improve the Service.
- To meter usage, settle credits, and pay providers.
- To communicate about your account, security and service changes.
- To detect, prevent and investigate abuse and security incidents.
- To comply with legal obligations.

## 4. Workload content & receipts

We aim to minimize exposure to your workload content. R+2 receipts hash action arguments and results — they record that an action occurred without storing the raw inputs. Storage objects are controlled by you and may be client-encrypted; you hold the keys.

## 5. Legal bases

Where applicable (e.g. under GDPR/DPDP-style regimes), we process personal data on the bases of contract performance, legitimate interests (security, service operation), consent (where required), and legal obligation.

## 6. Sharing

We share data with infrastructure sub-processors (e.g. database, hosting and email providers) under contract, with network providers only as needed to route and settle workloads, and with authorities where legally required. We do not sell personal data.

## 7. International transfers

Data may be processed in jurisdictions other than your own. Where required, we use appropriate safeguards for cross-border transfers.

## **8. Security**

We use industry-standard measures including encryption in transit, access controls, structured audit logging, and key-hash-only storage of API credentials. No system is perfectly secure; we work to protect data commensurate with its sensitivity.

## **9. Retention**

We retain personal data for as long as needed to provide the Service and meet legal, accounting and security obligations, then delete or anonymize it. Immutable receipts of actions may persist by design even where underlying content is erased.

## **10. Your rights**

Subject to applicable law, you may request access, correction, deletion, portability, or restriction of your personal data, and may object to certain processing. TRD Storage supports cryptographic erasure of stored content on request (e.g. GDPR Art. 17), while the receipt of the action remains.

## **11. Cookies**

The website uses essential cookies to operate and may use limited analytics. Where required, non-essential cookies are used only with consent.

## **12. Children**

The Service is not directed to individuals under 18, and we do not knowingly collect their personal data.

## **13. Changes**

We may update this Policy; material changes will be posted with a revised effective date.
